

Are You Ready For The Real Air and Sea Show?

When time ends as we know it, God will send his angels to gather his elect from the air, land and sea; and they will be flying through the air to meet God! Only those who are born again will make it and the rest perish in tribulation.

However, a recent national survey found that about fifty percent of the American population claimed to be "born-again Christians." What is meant by the term "born-again Christian," and what is the understanding of those people who call themselves "born-again Christians?"

These claims are stemmed from the following phrase that have become apart of many preachers' altar call,

"Just accept Christ into your heart through prayer and he'll receive you. It doesn't matter what church you belong to or if you ever do good works. You'll be born again at the moment you receive Christ. He's at the door knocking. You don't even have to change bad habits, just trust Christ as Savior. God loves you and forgives you unconditionally. Anyone out there can be saved if they ... Accept Christ, now! Let us pray for Christ to now come into your heart." [Actual statement]

The term Christian, doesn't necessarily denotes that one is born again; also, saying one is born again doesn't make one born again.

Christ tells us, "Except a man be born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God" (John 3:3). This simply means that unless one is born again he cannot be saved or take part in the final Air and Sea Show. So then, the mere title Christian alone won't get anyone into heaven and distant from hell's fire.

In fact, Noah, his wife, their sons and their sons wives alone couldn't have built the Ark. Some of Noah's friends probably joined in, but didn't believe to go into the ark. Noah's friends could be considered Christians and those that went into the ark as born again Christians. So being a Christian (church goer, acceptance of Christ or a good person) won't help you in this final show.

In other words, though many have cling to the title Christian and have even been philanthropic, unless one is born of the water and of the spirit one cannot enter in the kingdom of God; or in essence, be saved (John 3:5).

Saying you're born again doesn't make it so either. In fact, one can only be born again by God. For the Greek rendering of the term born again is born from above.

Therefore, unless one repents -turn upward to God and consequently turning one's back on one's past life- one cannot be born again.

After turning to God he then commands us to have faith in water baptism for the removal of our sins (Acts 2:38). He also wants us to tarry or wait for the Holy Ghost "but tarry ye until ye be endued with power from on high" (born of the spirit).



After receiving the Holy Ghost one will become new, "if any man be in Christ he is a new creature." In essence, one will be able to serve God and keep his commandments fully. That's one of the essential purposes of the Holy Ghost as stated in Eze 36:27.

Now every prominent Holy Ghost conversion in the New Testament showed believers speaking in an unknown tongue when they were spirit baptized. This is one of the reasons it is a fact that anyone

who doesn't speak in an unknown tongue upon alleged baptism of the Holy Ghost doesn't have life.

We can therefore biblically conclude that a mere statement of belief doesn't make one born again. Faith saves when faith obeys.

"By faith Noah being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house, by which he condemned the world and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith"(Heb 11:7).

By faith we being instructed by God (Math 28:19, Acts 2:38, Mark 16:16) should also move with fear, be water baptize in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and wait in belief for the baptism of the Holy Ghost; which together, will save your soul.

Notice that by faith Noah believed God and built the ark, though it had never rained on the earth before. Similarly, we have never seen an Air and Sea Show as was prophesied (Matt 24:31), but those who are smart will prepare by becoming born again; and not ending up like the people outside the ark in Noah's days, who mocked him and were all drowned in the flood.

Choose today what will it be, prepare and condemn the world like Noah or continue like the people who knew of the prophecy but choose not to get into the ark. Friend, unlike today it won't be a show. - O.M
